At the San Francisco Marriott Marquis, we are committed to being a leader in water, hygiene, and energy technologies to ensure our local communities and broader planet have an optimistic and better future. Some of our sustainability efforts are wide-ranging and some are on the smaller side. Here's what we are proud of:

- Energy-efficient LED lighting in all spaces of the hotel
- All guestroom and public restrooms have been retrofitted city approved water-saving showerheads, toilets, and faucets
- All public restrooms sink faucets have hand motion activation to save water
- · Water bottle refill stations are located on the 1st and 2nd floors
- Guestroom's HVAC units are equipped with a centralized Inncom energy system that utilizes digital thermostats, door lock switches, and motion sensors to insure the best possible energy performance.
- $\bullet \quad \text{All guestroom HVAC motors have been replaced with energy-saving variable speed motors} \\$
- Light sensors for energy savings, in offices and storage rooms
- $\bullet \quad \text{Main HVAC systems are all retrofitted with variable drive technology} \text{electric motor energy savings} \\$
- Recycled paper used throughout the hotel
- Trash is hand separated to insure all recyclables are pulled out. The monthly recycle rate is over 80%
- Other special items recycled include cooking grease/oil, batteries, lightbulbs, paints, and electronics
- Purchasing preference is given to local and sustainable product suppliers in order to lower carbon footprint
- Only certified green chemicals from EcoLab are used to clean guestrooms and public spaces.
- Property is in the process of switching to residential amenities which eliminates all the little bottles of soap, shampoo, and conditioner
- All utility usages and bills are reviewed by a 3rd party which helps flag possible energy waste and water leaks.
- Guestrooms are equipped with a cell phone mobile key system reduces plastic waste
- Hotel holds an "Environmentalist Level" certificate from the California Green Lodging for reducing waste, saving water, energy, and other valuable resources

- Water stations used in all meeting spaces to reduce waste
- Water cups are green and recyclable
- Composting of all food waste

- Air Handlers have economizers to utilize outside air to cool the spaces
- Automated HVAC efficiency system conserves energy when meeting rooms are unoccupied

- Event Space meets California lighting code Title 24 and are equipped LED's, motion, and light level sensors
