Submit for review

Please submit your Risk Assessment, technical drawings, visuals and method statement to Abraxys for review

Plans Received

Once Abraxys receive your plans we will review these against our internal guidelines and the H&S guidelines set out by Informa and the city of Cape Town





Abraxys will submit the forms and arrange approval on behalf of the client

Height – Cape Town

If your stand is **3m** or over you need to submit a BDM 12 and a SANS form to Abraxys along with your stand design

Abraxys Response

You should expect to hear back from Abraxys with either sign off or next steps for sign off within 72 hours.



Abraxys will let the client know your stand has been approved – until then sit tight.

Don't Forget your BDM 13!

Abraxys will email you to remind that you should arrange for the stand to have a BDM13 signed off onsite as well as your preevent forms.

For a few very complex stands you may need one more step....



Onsite BDM13 sign off

All stands must be signed off with a BDM13 onsite at the show by Adema Structural Consultancy. Contact <u>douwe@polka.co.za</u> to arrange.

Once Calculations are received

The stand can be signed off by our structural engineers and the process is now finished. You will receive an email confirming Permission to Build from Abraxys.
